- How should we interpret the fleece story in light of the entire Gideon story?
- What is God's general reason for thinning Gideon's army?
 - What's the purpose of the first 'test'? (7:3)
 - What's the purpose of the second 'test'? (7:4-8)
- Is God telling Gideon to go 'eavesdrop'? Offering the opportunity? Why do this?
- What does the dream and its interpretation teach Gideon?
- Describe the tactics of Gideon's army and how it might have worked.
- Who is enlisted to "finish the job" in 7:24-25?
