

### "12 Everyday Rules from The Word"

- 1. WAKE UP!... And decide to have a good day! "Today is the day the Lord hath made; let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalms 118:24).
- RISE UP!...And do the right thing! "Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? or who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity?" (1 Samuel 16:7).
- 3. **STAND UP!**...For what you believe in? Stand for something or you will fall for anything! "Let us not be weary in doing good; for at the proper time, we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good" (Galatians 6:9-10).
- 4. **LOOK UP!**...To the Lord! "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13).
- 5. **REACH UP!**...For something higher! "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not unto your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge Him, And He will direct your path" (Proverbs 3:5-6).
- 6. WISE UP!...To the fact that no man nor body of men are wiser than the Lord above! "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; but fools despise wisdom and instruction" (Proverbs 1:7).

- 7. **LIFT UP!**...Your Prayers to God! "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything be prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God" (Philippians 4:6).
- 8. LISTEN UP!...Who can instruct us better than our Creator? "He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul; but he that hearth reproof getteth understanding" (Proverbs 15:32).
- 9. **FACE UP!...**To the fact that there is a God above and He has everything in His control! "For the Lord Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth" (Psalms 47:2).

#### 2000 Years Later

Two thousand years ago, a little old man sat in a cold prison cell writing on a piece of parchment.
