Mountain of Edom (3	35:1-15)
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Widultaili di Eddii (33.1-13)
- Mount Seir is the mountain in Edom, the descendants of (35:2)
- God says they the sons of Israel to the sword, so He will give them over to bloodshed. (3-9; see the Book of Obadiah)
- Edom believed they would the land of Israel once the people were destroyed/carried away. (10-15)
- God says their arrogance is ultimately directed at (13) Why?
- Why is this judgment on Mount Seir included in this section on hope?
Mountains of Israel (36:1-15)
- God now speaks to the mountains of Israel, against whom He had prophesied judgment in chapter 6 for
- Here, He says that they have suffered reproach for reason. (36:1-3)
- God assures them first that He has spoken judgment against (4-7
- Then, He promises to them again. How is this described? (8-12)
- The mountains of Israel will never again be by the nations. (13-15)
