Philippians Class Lesson 5 Philippians 2:5-11

1. What does it mean to have the same mindset as Jesus Christ? (Phil. 2:5)

2. Where are your attitudes most like and unlike Christ? Consider this statement: Being a disciple involves imitating your teacher in character, mindset, and actions.

3. Jesus became human – He took on humanity! He gave up the advantages of the Godhead and "made Himself nothing" vs. 7. What examples can you point out in the gospels – Matt. 4:2; Mark 13:32; John 4:6, 6:38, 11:33-35 and 19:28

4. Jesus always showed complete dependance on His Father (John 5:19, 8:28 & 14:10.) What are the lessons from this example?

5. Jesus said in Mark 10:45 "did not come to be served but to serve" (Mark 10:45) If you live like this can you be sure your needs will be met?

6. How does God reward those who humbly serve? (Luke 18:14)

7. How do you respond when you realize (consider) what Jesus gave up coming to this world and sacrificing His life to pay for your sins?

8. Why is it that you seldom see a service-oriented person today?

9. What are the steps to a life of servanthood?

10. If a church were (all the sudden) filled with humble servants would the atmosphere change?

11. How can a life of servanthood – putting others first & refusing to promote yourself – be a path to glory and joy?
